

NEW COVID PROTOCOLS FOR E91 KIDS

▶ Weekly registration will be **required** before attending E91Kids. Spaces in each classroom will be limited according to volunteer availability. Registration for each week will open every Monday at Noon.

▶ Due to limited registrations in each classroom, children will only be permitted to stay for one service.

▶ The current breakdown of classrooms will be as follows:

○ **Preschool**

- Nursery (Birth-1)
- Ones and Twos
- Threes through PreK

○ **Elementary**

- K-5th grade Large Group Setting

▶ Please evaluate the health of your immediate family before attending E91Kids each week. If you have questionable health symptoms, please stay home and engage on-line.

▶ We request everyone age 3 and up to wear mask while at E91.

▶ Sanitation stations will be set up to sanitize your hands before and after you check in your child(ren).

▶ Drop times will begin 10 minutes before the 9:15 and 10:45 services. Please pick-up your child immediately after the service so the room can be sanitized for following service.

▶ At classroom, volunteers will ask your family questions regarding Covid. If you answer “yes” to any of these questions, you will be asked to speak with the ministry leader.

- In the last 24 hours, has anyone in your household had a fever and/or taken medication for a fever?
- In the last 7 days, has anyone in your household had symptoms of a lower respiratory illness such as coughing or difficulty breathing?
- In the past 14 days has anyone in your household been in close contact with a person know/suspected to have COVID-19 and/or have you been diagnosed with COVID-19?

▶ Children’s hands will be sanitized before entering the room. Handwashing in the classroom will take place after restroom breaks and as needed.

▶ No parents will be allowed in the classrooms. Volunteers will escort children in and out of class.

▶ No snacks will be given for children 3 and up. Children in the 1s and 2s class will be given Cheerios and water in sippy cups provided by E91Kids. Children in Nursery will be given bottles and snacks provided by each family.

▶ While social distancing is extremely difficult, the volunteer staff will do their best to do so when appropriate.

▶ Any toy that has been put into mouths will be washed immediately. All other toys and surfaces will be cleaned at the end of service and any other times deemed appropriate.
