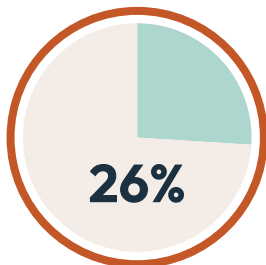


Northside Campus Get Ready

BUDGET FOR 2026-2027

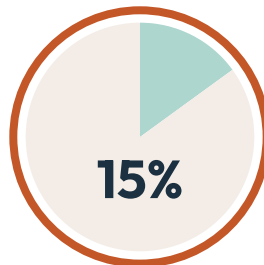
TOTAL BUDGET \$3,900,000

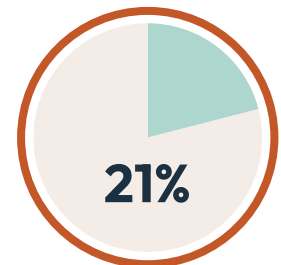

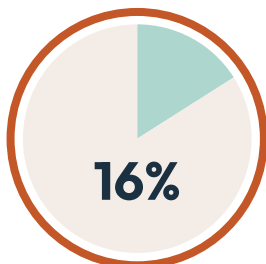

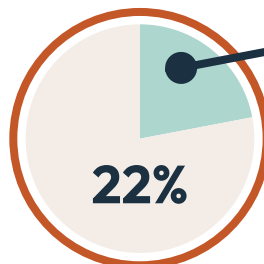
